were distributed- with opportunity to see the students a chance to get though it may have felt caps in the air for the out amazing, and stud it on the day graduation

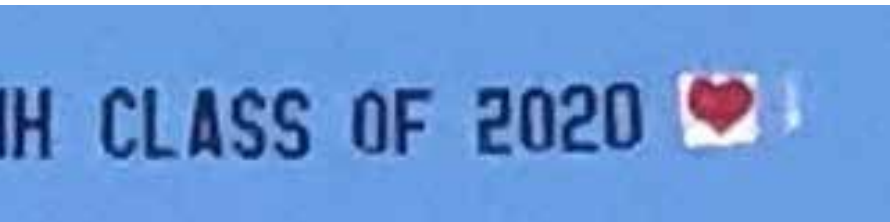
